Abstract Submission Guidelines

Subject Line: Please mention "J.C. Kothari – Young Scientist Award" in the subject line of your email.

Word Limit: Abstracts must not exceed 350 words.

Structure: Your abstract should be clearly structured under the following headings:

• Title • Introduction • Methods • Results • Conclusion

You may submit a maximum of 2 abstracts for the award.

However, only one (the higher-scoring one) will be considered for the final presentation.

Selection Criteria

The top 6 abstracts will be selected for presentation during the J.C. Kothari Award Session at NAPCON Jaipur.

Presentations will be evaluated during the session by an expert panel.

Awards

The award includes First, Second, and Third Prizes, presented by the Indian Chest Society (ICS).
